1 LOW INCOME HOUSING

Would you support the creation of a National Housing Trust Fund to assist local community efforts to finance the building of additional affordable housing units?

2 FEDERALLY FINANCED ABORTION RESTRICTIONS

Currently, federal taxpayer funds may not be used to pay for abortions except in the following cases: pregnancy resulting from rape or incest or if a woman is in danger of death unless an abortion is performed. Would you support the continuation of this federal policy?

3 IMMIGRATION

Would you support an approach to immigration reform that, in addition to increased resources for border enforcement, includes an earned legalization program enabling undocumented workers to earn lawful status by demonstrating gainful employment, good moral character and the payment of income related taxes?

4 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

Would you support an amendment to the U.S. Constitution defining marriage as a union of a man and a woman?

5 NATIVE HAWAIIAN RECOGNITION

Would you support federal recognition for Native Hawaiians as represented in the Akaka bill?

6 HUMAN CLONING

Would you support legislation to ban human cloning?

7 SUDAN

Would you support increased U.S. intervention in Sudan?

8 CAPITAL PUNISHMENT

Would you support legislation to prevent the expanded application of the federal death penalty?

9 BUSINESS TAX CREDIT FOR EDUCATION

Would you support legislation creating a federal tax credit for corporation donations to organizations providing scholarships to low-income public and nonpublic school students for tuition, tutoring, special needs services and technology equipment?
