- 10 Would you vote for legislation enabling prosecution of third party perpetrators (excluding physicians and surgeons) who injure or kill an unborn child/fetus when criminally assaulting or otherwise criminally injuring the mother?
- 11 Would you vote to require parental notification before a minor obtains an abortion?
