PHYSICIAN-ASSISTED SUICIDE (HB 675) DEFEATED BY HOUSE HEALTH COMMITTEE

On Wednesday, February 6, 2007, after hours of excellent debate, [Rep. Josh Green](#), [Rep. John Mizuno](#), [Rep. James Tokioka](#), [Rep. Gene Ward](#) and [Rep. Karen Awana](#) voted TO HOLD (or kill) the assisted suicide bill.

[Rep. Maile Shimabukuro](#) voted with reservations to hold (or kill the bill); however, she expressed support for the bill and is an author of the bill.

[Rep. Della Au Belatti](#) voted against holding (killing) it in committee and urged the committee to pass it to the floor for a full floor vote. She is an author of the proposal.
