Sudan Divestment Bill (HB 34) Headed to the Governor

Great news! HB 34, which would require divestment of Hawaii employee retirement system (ERS) funds from companies that support the genocide-complicit Sudanese government, has passed overwhelmingly in both the House & Senate and is now headed for the Governor's office.

The government in Sudan is complicit in a genocide that has cost the lives of 400,000 people (1/3 our state population) and displaced over 2 million more. Every day in Darfur, women and children are raped and tortured. We must take a stand!
