[ABORTION BILL \(HB 1242 HD1\)](#) PASSES SENATE JUDICIARY!

HB 1242 HD1 has passed the Senate Judiciary Committee without any changes. It will now move to the Senate floor for a vote by the full Senate.

Now is the time to make that call to your own Senator if you have not done so already.

The best argument we can make to stop this bill is that it **GOES FURTHER THAN CURRENT CONSTITUTIONAL CASE LAW REQUIRES, ALLOWING LATE 2ND AND 3RD TRIMESTER ABORTIONS IN CLINICS - NOT HOSPITALS.** *Allowing such later term abortions in an outpatient setting endangers women's health.* To be most effective in your advocacy, please limit your arguments to this point.
