ONE DAY LEFT TO CONTACT GOVERNOR LINGLE — ASK FOR VETO OF [ABORTION BILL \(HB 1242 HD1\)](#)!

Please call Governor Lingle on Wednesday. The Governor must make her decision on the abortion bill (HB 1242 HD1) by April 27, 2006. If you have not done so already, please contact her office [by e-mailing the Governor \(click for link\)](#) or calling her office (808) 586-0034 and politely ask her to VETO the bill to protect women's health and safety.

Please do NOT make general arguments against abortion. Governor Lingle is pro-choice and that approach will not be effective.

Please remember that the best argument we can make to stop this bill is that it **GOES FURTHER THAN CURRENT CONSTITUTIONAL CASE LAW REQUIRES, ALLOWING LATE 2ND AND 3RD TRIMESTER ABORTIONS IN CLINICS - NOT HOSPITALS. *Allowing such later term abortions in an outpatient setting endangers women's health.***
