

URGENT LEGISLATIVE ALERT

CALL THE HOUSE LEADERSHIP TODAY—AND YOUR OWN REPRESENTATIVE—TELL THEM THAT YOU SUPPORT THE SENATE VERSION OF SB 2843 AND OPPOSE THE HOUSE VERSION.

Megan's Law (via Constitutional Amendment) allows parents access to the list of registered sex offenders in their neighborhoods. 48 other states have a Megan's law. Hawaii had one too until the Hawaii Supreme Court ruled it unconstitutional. The Senate version overturns the Supreme Court decision allowing for the protection of children and families via a constitutional amendment, or vote of the people. The House version simply codifies the unworkable Supreme Court decision and does not protect children and families from sexual predators. HFF stands with the Department of the Attorney General, the Hawaii State Senate, the Hawaii Law Enforcement Coalition, and the Victim Witness Kokua Services in asking you to contact the House Leadership—and your own Representative—to support the Senate version.

Action:

1. Call, write, or fax the following House Leadership members, and your own Representative, and tell them you SUPPORT the Senate version of Megan's Law because the House version doesn't go far enough to protect Hawaii's keiki
2. Ask your family, friends, and neighbors to do the same
