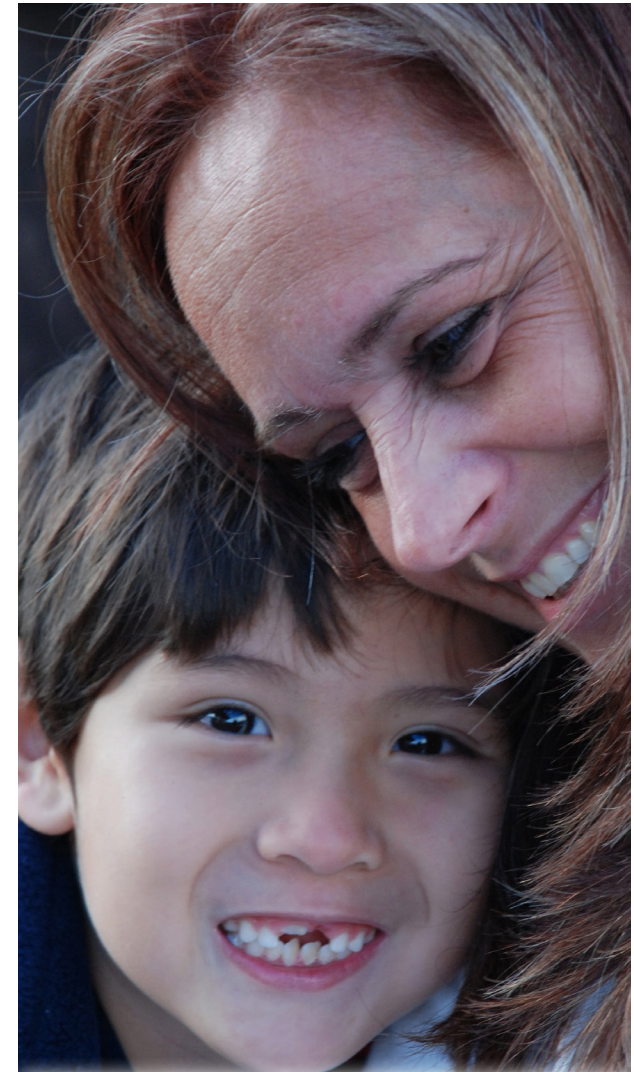

- Protecting all people from human trafficking
- Supporting affordable housing for all
- Supporting treatment and prevention of drug abuse
- Protecting the ohana from domestic violence

### Faith & Religious Freedom

- Protection of religious freedoms for individuals, pastors, and churches
- Ensuring the government does not force religious institutions, or people of faith, from acting contrary to their deeply held religious convictions
- Support of a Religious Freedom Restoration Act
