Requires confidentiality policies and practices for insurers and health care providers.</i>	<i>Relaxes the requirements for prescribing certain controlled substances as part of gender-affirming health care services. Expands the protections established under Act 2, SLH 2023, to include gender-affirming health care services.</i> <b>PASSED IN THE HOUSE. NOT HEARD IN THE SENATE</b>
